

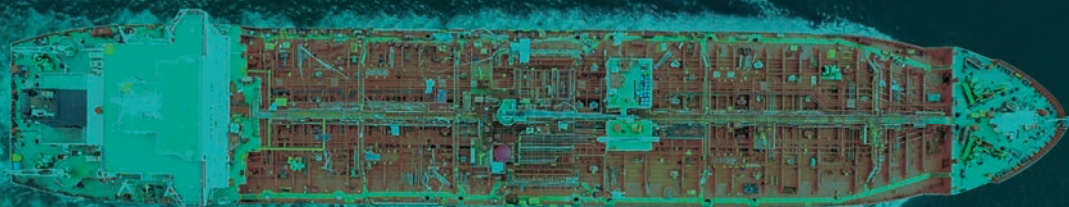

Green Maritime Day will convene national and international stakeholders from the maritime, energy, and transport sectors to discuss sustainable shipping solutions, including green shipping corridors, green fuel bunkering and exports, zero-emission trucks, maritime pollution, and shore power integration. Participants will have the opportunity to learn from global leaders, gain insights into best practices, and identify actionable opportunities across the maritime value chain. Sessions will explore India's strategic advantages, technology readiness, and policy frameworks, fostering collaboration and innovation. This platform aims to accelerate decarbonisation, share knowledge, and shape the future of green shipping in India and globally.
